The Weather

The weather depends on temperature, precipitation and wind.

When the temperature is high, it's hot. When the temperature is low, it's cold. The temperature is measured with a thermometer. Precipitation occurs when



water falls from the clouds onto the Earth. The water can be in the form of rain, snow or hail. Rainfall is measured with a rain gauge. Wind is moving air. It can be soft like a breeze or strong like a hurricane. The weathervane shows the direction of the wind.


