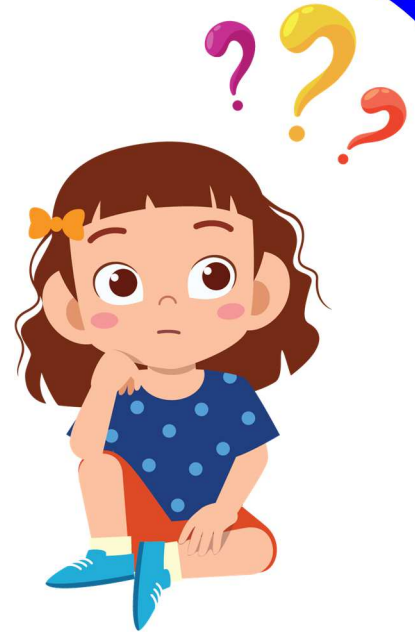


# Make Inferences and Draw Conclusions

2. Think about your prior knowledge of the subject.
3. Use your own experiences.
4. Search for clues in the text.
5. Connect the clues, your experiences, and what you know.
6. Finally, draw conclusions.
