And I grow on trees.

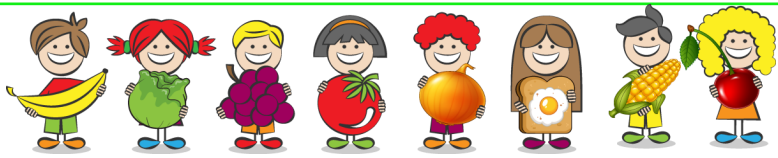
I'm a popular food

I have many layers that will bring you to tears as you peel them away.



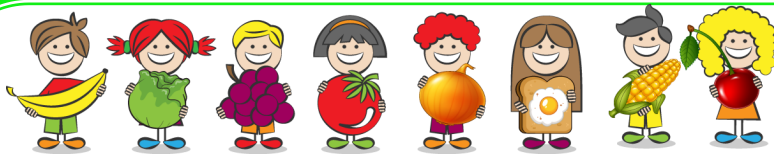

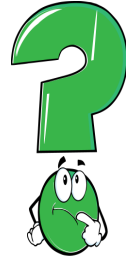
I'm as sweet as honey
