4. Sarah has read 5 books this month. If she reads 5 more, how many books will she have read altogether?
5. Zoey made bracelets for her 6 friends. She decides to make 3 extra. How many bracelets are there now?
6. Michael likes to catch butterflies. On Monday he caught 7 butterflies in the morning. In the afternoon he caught 5 butterflies. How many butterflies did he catch on Monday?
7. Hannah is playing tag with her 8 friends. If 4 more join in, how many friends are playing with her?
8. Adam is building a sand castle with his sister. He built 9 towers and his sister built 4 towers. How many towers are there?
9. Anna has a lemonade stand and sold 8 cups of lemonade. If she sells 5 more, how many cups of lemonade will she sell?
10. Olivia received 6 letters in the mail. If she receives 4 more today, how many letters will she have?
