1. Roger is practicing his singing. If he practiced 18 minutes yesterday and 11 minutes today, how long has he practiced altogether?
2. Ellen and her sister skipped rocks at a lake. Ellen skipped 15 rocks and her sister skipped 8, how many rocks have they skipped?
3. Sam baked some cookies. Sam loves cookies. He ate 12 before dinner and 6 after dinner. How many cookies did he eat?
4. Lisa painted a beautiful forest. If she painted 4 oak trees and 16 pine trees, how many trees did she paint in all?
5. Jeff rode his bike today. He passed 14 houses on his way to the park and 16 houses on his way home. How many houses did he pass?
6. Rachel loves to shop for clothes. If she bought 8 dresses and 10 shirts, how many clothes did she buy?
7. Scott made paper airplanes. If he made 7 with yellow paper and 12 with blue, how many paper airplanes did he make?
8. Andrea skated around the rink 11 times. She took a break and then skated 6 more times around the rink. How many times did she skate around the roller skating rink?
9. Zane has a collection of 19 comic books. If he buys 12 more, how many will he have?
10. Julia counted the flowers on a bush. If there are 6 white ones and 14 blue ones, how many flowers are there in all?
