1. Joe read 11 comic books and 2 chapter books during the summer. His sister read 8 comic books. How many books did Joe read during the summer?



2. Sharon baked 24 cookies on Saturday. Her friend, Molly, baked 13 chocolate chip cookies. Molly also baked 14 sugar cookies on Saturday. How many cookies did Molly bake?



3. It took Carlos 15 minutes to finish his Math homework. Then, he watched TV for 30 minutes. After that, he worked on his Reading homework for 10 minutes. How long did it take Carlos to do all of his homework?



4. Marie found 3 pairs of dirty socks under her bed. She found 5 pairs of shoes in her closet and 9 pairs of socks in her drawer. How many pairs of socks did Marie find?



5. Chuck opened a big bag of Skittles. He made a pile for each color. There were 6 purple, 8 blue, 9 yellow, 11 green, and 8 red. How many green and red Skittles did he have?



6. Bob counted all of the blocks in his toy box. There were 7 green ones, eight blue, seven red and nine yellow blocks. How many blue and red blocks does he have altogether?
