2. Camping with the family is fun. Denise grabbed her sack and went hiking with her dad. Along the trail, Denise found 10 shiny rocks and put them in her bag. Her dad picked up 8 small branches to use in the campfire. Denise added 13 acorns to her bag. When they got back to camp, how many things did Denise have in her bag?
3. Denise and her brother, Manny, walked along the beach. Manny hunted for smooth, flat rocks to skip across the water. He found 9 perfect rocks. Denise picked up 6 seashells that had washed up on shore. As they walked Manny found 8 more smooth, flat rocks. How many rocks did Manny find to skip across the water?
4. There were many tents and campers in the campground. Denise counted 9 tents set up by campers. She also spotted 12 boys and 6 girls. How many children did Denise count in the campground?
5. Night brings many surprises on a camping trip. Manny caught 15 fireflies in his net. Denise spotted 3 cottontail rabbits hopping into the woods near them. Denise grabbed her net and was able to catch 11 fireflies. How many fireflies did Manny and Denise find when they emptied their nets?
