1. Hugh is chopping wood. If he chopped 18 logs and used 12 for a fire, how many logs are left?



2. Lily is modeling for a magazine. She had 16 pictures taken but only 5 were used for the magazine. How many pictures were not used for the magazine?



3. Max is a science teacher. He has 27 students in his class. This morning 12 of them left to take a test. How many students were left in his class this morning?



4. Ted is a mailman. If he had 19 letters and delivered 12 of them, how many letters are left to deliver?



5. Dora is on a road trip. She has 18 towns she wants to visit. So far, she has visited 5 of the towns. How many more towns does she need to visit?



6. Donald is grocery shopping. He has only 15 items he needs to buy. He already has 7 in his cart. How many more items does he need to buy?



7. Mary has 24 tulips to give to her friends. She gave out 16. How many more tulips can she give to friends?



8. Ken is in a chess competition. If he has 11 opponents and has beaten 5, how many more opponents does he have left?



9. Jenny has 14 books she wants to read. She read 9 of them last week. How many books does she have left to read?



10. Bob is grilling hamburgers for a birthday party. He grilled 15 and only 7 were eaten. How many hamburgers are left?
