The nurse is the professional who cares for and attends to the sick and wounded.

The nurse is responsible for giving medication to the sick, caring for their wounds, giving patients injections or vaccines, taking their temperature, or following any other instructions given by the doctor.

Nurses work in hospitals, clinics, nursing homes, and in the homes of the sick. They use medical equipment, such as a blood pressure gauge (blood pressure monitor), thermometer, needles, scales, and much more.

All nurses must be careful and hygienic in their work. They wear protective clothing to prevent getting sick from their patients.
