Types of Plants

Depending on the stem, plants can be grasses, shrubs or trees. Grasses have a soft, thin, flexible stem.



Shrubs have many hard and thin stems emerging from the ground.



Trees have a hard, thick stem, called a trunk. From the trunk come branches beginning at a certain height from the ground. Deciduous trees such as almond trees, lose their leaves in the fall. The evergreens, such as pine trees, maintain green leaves all year.
