Who created the Theory of Relativity?

Albert Einstein was born in Ulm, Germany. He did not speak until the age of 4. One day at dinner, he said, "The soup is hot." His parents, surprised, asked why, if he knew how to speak, he hadn't done so before. He replied, "Because until now, everything was fine."

Albert was a curious child and asked questions about everything: space, how starlight came to his eyes, the weather, and much more.

He studied physics and published various theories. The most important was the "Theory of Relativity," which says that everything that happens depends on the point of view of the observer. He developed the formula that a few atoms can be converted into powerful energy. Unfortunately, the formula was used to create and manufacture the atomic bomb.

He won the Nobel Prize in Physics.

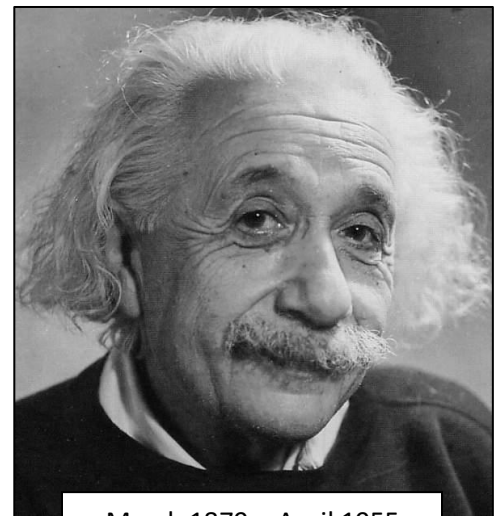

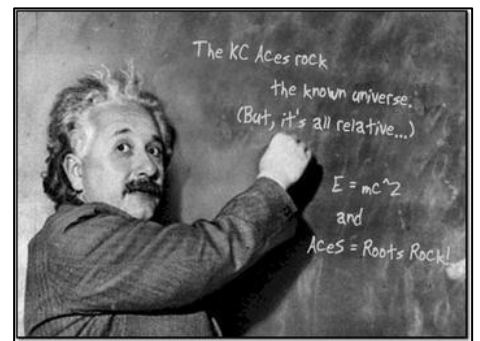
