Who was an actress and First Lady of Argentina?

Evita Peron was an actress and politician from Argentina. She married the President of Argentina, becoming the First Lady of Argentina.

Evita Peron was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Her father was a politician. Evita grew up with her four brothers in the countryside. She loved the theater. When she was fifteen, Evita moved to the city. There she worked as an actress for several years.

Evita Peron married Juan Peron, President of Argentina. She worked hard to get the female vote for her husband. She organized social aid for the poor while working for the State. In 1949, she was the most beloved figure of the working classes in Argentina. Evita Peron was given the title of "Spiritual Leader of the Nation."

Evita Peron died very young on July 26, 1952, of leukemia.
