## Who was the most influential Spanish poet of the 20<sup>th</sup> century?

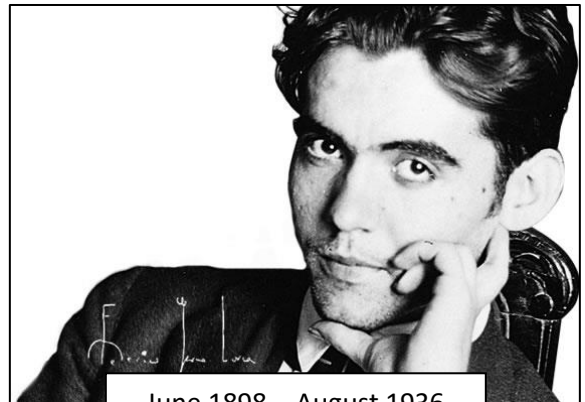
Federico Garcia Lorca was a Spanish poet.
