Judge

Judges are in charge of administering justice. Most work in courts of law.

They make the final decisions in lawsuits and other legal processes like divorces and inheritance claims. They decide whether an accused person is innocent or guilty and decide on the punishment for those found guilty. While deciding on a verdict the judge will look at the evidence in a trial and listen to the testimony of people.

Judges then make decisions fairly and impartially. The decisions made by judges are called judgments. Judgments should be based on the application of the law.

Judges use a special garment called a robe.
