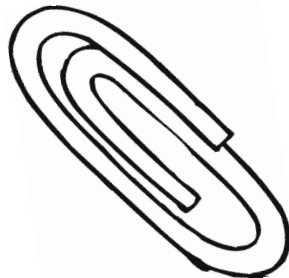
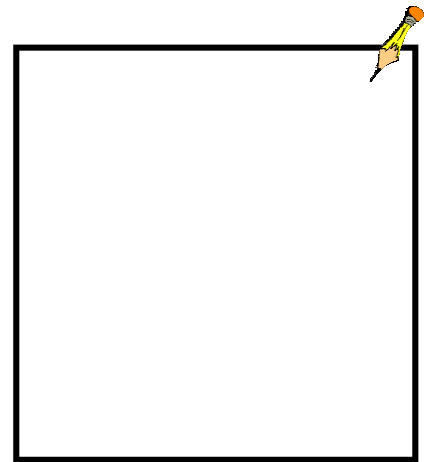
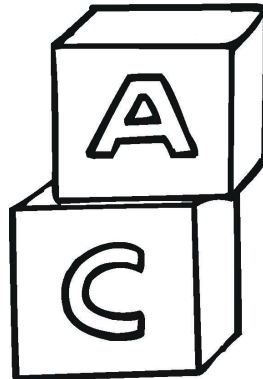
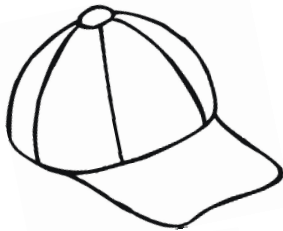
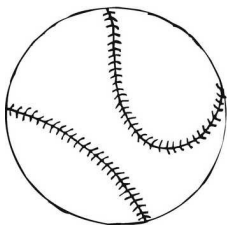
Magnets

Magnets are materials that attract objects made of certain metals without actually touching them. This is possible because they have a force acting at a distance, called a magnetic force. Magnets can be natural, such as the mineral magnetite, or man-made.



Magnets are used for many things, for example, the doors to cupboards and refrigerators, the closure for handbags and purses, in compasses, toys and in some credit cards.
