Proper nouns are words used to designate people, animals, places, or things. They always begin with a capital letter. For example: Francisco, Francia.

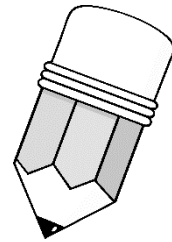
Common nouns are the words used to name everything in general. For example: woman, wood, dog, planet, scissors.
