Determine if the following words are proper nouns (example: Hilda) or common nouns (example: wheat). On the line, write proper and the word written correctly, or common and write the word as it is.

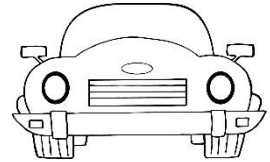
