Salvador Dali was born in Figueras, a city in Spain. He had two brothers. His father was a lawyer. Salvador Dali was a bright child. He displayed his first art exhibition at the age of 14. He studied Fine Arts in Madrid and Paris. Shortly afterward, he married a Russian artist named Gala.

Salvador Dali painted over a thousand pictures. He was also a skilled draftsman, sculptor, printmaker, stage designer, and Spanish writer.
