



Water Cycle



The heat of the sun heats the water and transforms it from liquid to a gas called vapor: evaporation. The water vapor rises to the sky, cools, and forms the clouds: condensation. The drops of rain join and become heavier. Afterwards, they fall to the ground in the form of rain: precipitation. The water runs off the land (runoff) until it arrives to a river, a lake, or the ocean: collection. Finally, the cycle begins over again.
